Ramapo Tomato and Moreton Tomato Seeds and Jersey Tomato Tee Shirts

The 'Ramapo' hybrid tomato was developed at Rutgers New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES) and released in 1968. This medium-sized tomato was prized by gardeners due to its wonderful flavor, combined with excellent fruit quality, reliability, and productivity. While Ramapo seed was not commercially available for many years, Rutgers continued receiving requests for this popular tomato. Through a special effort, Rutgers NJAES has reintroduced Ramapo F-1 seeds for people who appreciate eating quality tomatoes.

The *Rediscovering the Jersey Tomato* project of Rutgers NJAES, in cooperation with Eastern Seed Services and Harris Seeds, has restored Moreton F-1 Hybrid, another old-time—EARLY MATURING—tasty Jersey Tomato variety long absent from the market. Moreton makes a good earlier maturing garden companion while waiting for Ramapo to mature, and like Ramapo, combines hybrid reliability with old-time taste.

Your purchases of seeds and tee shirts help support our research efforts to bring tasty tomatoes back to consumers.

Ramapo F1 Hybrid seeds - Mid to late season; resistant to cracking and Verticillium and Fusarium wilt. Semi-determinate plants approximately 80 days to maturity. Medium - large sized fruit. Gardener feedback from our 2008 survey indicates that Ramapo tomato grows well in a variety of U.S. regions.

Moreton F1 Hybrid seeds - Early season, resistant to Verticillium. Indeterminate plants mature in 70 days. Medium - large sized fruit. A heavier feeder on less fertile soil. Treated seed. Favorite in extreme climates with short growing seasons.

Note: gardeners may experience a wide range of fruit size produced by tomato plants depending on weather, garden location, and cultural practices including fertilizer, irrigation, pruning, and pest management. See gardening tips links below.
